For the purpose of approving, in accordance with the provisions of the Zoning Ordinance of			
Prince George's	County, Maryland, a Minor Plan Amendment to amend the 2009 Countywide		
Master Plan of T	Transportation to add language and amend subsequent maps to remove several		
parcels from right-of-way preservation of future master planned freeway F-10 (US 301) south of			
its interchange w	rith future master planned freeway F-6 (MD 4) and master planned expressway		
E-6 (MD 202).			
WHEREAS, on November 17, 2009, the Prince George's County Council, sitting as the			
District Council for that portion of the Maryland-Washington Regional District in Prince			
George's County ("District Council"), adopted CR-89-2009, approving the 2009 Countywide			
Master Plan of T	Transportation; and		
WHEREAS	S, on July 24, 2013, the District Council adopted CR-82-2013, approving the		
2013 Subregion 6 Master Plan, which amends the transportation facility recommendations of th			
2009 Approved	Countywide Master Plan of Transportation; and		
WHEREAS	S, the 2013 Subregion 6 Master Plan carried forward the recommendations of		
the 2009 Countywide Master Plan of Transportation for the construction of F-10, a master			
planned freeway to replace and bypass existing US 301 (Robert Crain Highway) to meet			
anticipated traffi	c demand; and		

WHEREAS, on May 6, 2014, the District Council adopted CR-26-2014, approving *Plan*

Prince George's 2035 ("Plan 2035"), the County's General Plan for growth and development, which further amended the 2009 *Countywide Master Plan of Transportation* to eliminate certain parcels from the right-of-way for the planned interchange of future master planned freeway F-10 (US 301) south of its interchange with future master planned freeway F-6 (MD 4) and master planned expressway E-6 (MD 202); and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the local zoning laws, on July 18, 2023, the District Council adopted CR-72-2023, initiating a minor amendment to the 2009 *Countywide Master Plan of Transportation*, for the purpose of revising the recommendations regarding a portion of the future F-10 project;

WHEREAS, the Prince George's County Planning Board, in conjunction with the District Council, pursuant to Sections 27-3502 and 27-3407 of the Zoning Ordinance, held a duly advertised joint public hearing on the proposed Minor Amendment to the 2009 *Countywide Master Plan of Transportation* on September 12, 2023, to receive public comment into the record on the proposed minor amendment; and

WHEREAS, after the close of the public hearing record, planning staff prepared a Technical Staff Report analyzing the proposed Minor Plan Amendment and public hearing testimony and made recommendations to the Planning Board for consideration; and

WHEREAS, on October 19, 2023, the Planning Board held a work session on the Minor Plan Amendment to examine the analysis of testimony presented at the September 12, 2023, Joint Public Hearing and exhibits received before the close of the record on September 27, 2023, and subsequently, on October 19, 2023, the Planning Board adopted the proposed minor plan amendment through resolution PGCPB No. 2023-113; and

WHEREAS, on November 7, 2023, the District Council conducted a public work session to examine the record of Joint Public Hearing testimony and the Planning Board's adoption of the proposed Minor Plan Amendment; and

WHEREAS, based upon testimony received into the record of Joint Public Hearing testimony, the County Council, sitting as the Committee of the Whole, voted to direct staff to prepare a Resolution of Approval for the minor amendment to the 2009 *Countywide Master Plan of Transportation* as adopted by the Planning Board in its resolution PGCPB No. 2023-113.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, sitting as the District Council for that part of the Maryland-Washington

Regional District in Prince George's County, Maryland, that, in accordance with Section 27-3502 of the Zoning Ordinance, the following adopted minor amendments to the 2009 *Countywide Master Plan of Transportation* are hereby APPROVED, as adopted by PGCPB No. 23-113, which is hereby incorporated as if set forth fully within this Resolution, and summarized below:

MINOR AMENDMENT ONE:

Insert the following language on page 46 of the 2009 *Countywide Master Plan of Transportation* after "STRATEGIES: 4. Show F-9 and F-10 south of the MD 5/US 301 interchange as study corridors, per the US 301 Waldorf Area Transportation Study.":

"The F-10 project shall not include any right of way or other preservation of the following properties: approximately 10.71 acres of property known as Parcel "C" of the "Penn - 301 Industrial Center," recorded among the land records of Prince George's County in Plat Book 71, at Plat Book Page No. 23, and generally bounded by Crain Highway (US 301) on the west,

Pennsylvania Avenue on the south, Chevy Drive along the north and east; approximately 15.711 acres of property known as Parcel "B-1," recorded among the land records of Prince George's

County in Plat Book NLP 103, at Plat Book Page No. 56, being generally bounded by Crain Highway (US 301) on the west, Pennsylvania Avenue on the north, and Maryland Route 976-C along the south; and approximately 31.76 acres recorded among the land records of Prince George's County in Liber 13481, at Folio 699, being generally bounded by Crain Highway (US 301) on the west, Pennsylvania Avenue on the north, and Maryland Route 976-C along the west."

MINOR AMENDMENT TWO:

Revise "Map 27" to remove any symbology pertaining to a Planned Freeway or Planned Interchange impacting the following properties: approximately 10.71 acres of property known as Parcel "C" of the "Penn – 301 Industrial Center," recorded among the land records of Prince George's County in Plat Book 71, at Plat Book Page No. 23, and generally bounded by Crain Highway (US 301) on the west, Pennsylvania Avenue on the south, Chevy Drive along the north and east; approximately 15.711 acres of property known as Parcel "B-1" recorded among the land records of Prince George's County in Plat Book NLP 103, at Plat Book Page No. 56, being generally bounded by Crain Highway (US 301) on the west, Pennsylvania Avenue on the north, Maryland Route 976-C along the south; and approximately 31.76 acres recorded among the land

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records of Prince George's County in Liber 13481, at folio 699, being generally bounded by Crain Highway (US 301) on the west, Pennsylvania Avenue on the north, Maryland Route 976-C along the west.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the foregoing minor amendments to the 2009 *Countywide Master Plan* also amend the applicable recommendations for the future master planned freeway F-10 (US 301) south of its interchange with future master planned freeway F-6 (MD 4) and master planned expressway E-6 (MD 202) within the 2013 *Subregion 6 Master Plan*.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the planning staff is authorized to correct any and all other potential inconsistencies in the text, map, and tables within the two master plans, in order to reflect the foregoing amendments approved by adoption of this Resolution.
